

# Play Like the Pros Charity Challenge

## Rules of Play

Glen Abbey Golf Club



- FORMAT:** 4-Person Team STABLEFORD
- HANDICAP:** 100% Handicap for Amateurs
- POINTS:** Points are awarded for ADJUSTED NET SCORE based on the following:
- Net Double Bogey + 0 points
  - Net Bogey 1 point
  - Net Par 2 points
  - Net Birdie 3 points
  - Net Eagle 4 points
  - Net Double Eagle 5 points
- SCORING:** Assign STABLEFORD points to amateur NET SCORE Add together for team total.
- TEES:** Men play from RBCCO Championship tees. Women play from Glen Abbey tees.
- PACE OF PLAY:** Please pick up your ball if you are no longer able to score a NET BOGEY.
- ABNORMAL GROUND** (Free drop, nearest point, no closer to the hole)  
**CONDITIONS:** French drains, which are exposed trenches, filled with rocks or stones.
1. Newly sodded areas
  2. Clearly marked Ground Under Repair
  3. Roads, paths and retaining walls
  4. Temporary Immovable Obstructions (e.g. RBCCO Tents and Signage)
  5. Staked trees
  6. Garden beds
- MEASUREMENT DEVICES:** Electronic measurement devices are permitted
- PROCEDURE:** When in doubt as to procedure – please play two balls, record both scores and a ruling will be issued following play. Do not sign or attest a scorecard if you have doubt as to procedure or a dispute. Please make a Golf Canada Foundation committee member or Glen Abbey Golf Professional Staff aware of your issue prior to signing or attesting scorecard.
- PLAYOFF:** Teams will choose two team members to represent their team in a two-person team Stableford format elimination playoff repeating through holes 17 & 18 if necessary.
